Each division will consist of 6 teams. **All teams will play three games.**

The six teams of each division, will play a two game round robin and will be awarded points for game and individual period outcomes.

- The 1st and 2nd place teams will play for the 'A' championship.
- The 3rd and 4th place teams will play for the 'B' championship.
- The 5th and 6th place teams will play for the 'C' championship.

Entry fee: \$525.00.

Teams will be guaranteed a spot on a first paid basis.

Rules and Regulations 2011

Team player lists must be presented prior to the teams first game. A player must play in at least one round robin game or serve a suspension to be eligible to play in the final game.

- Any colour clash and the visiting team must change sweaters.
- ODMHA regulations and Code of Discipline will apply to all teams.
- **Fighting and match penalties that occur will mean automatic ejection from the tournament.**
- No timeouts allowed.
- Teams must register and players must sign in at least ½ an hour prior to each game.
- Game sheets and sign-in must be obtained from the registration office, completed and returned to the office at least 15 minutes prior to each game.
- Travel permits (where required) must be obtained and provided with the registration form.
- No affiliate players are permitted to participate in the tournament.

THE POINT SYSTEM

All teams will play two games to determine which final they will play in. Points will be awarded as follows:

- 1 point - win a period,
- ½ point - tie a period,
- 1 point - tie a game,
- 2 points - win a game.

ROUND ROBIN TIES

If teams are tied after round robin play the following process will be used. First go head to head (most goals for) if still tied, then a percentage calculation is done (wins against losses), if still tied, least amount of penalties, if still tied 'goals for' divided by 'goals for' plus 'goals against'.

ADVANCE TO FINALS

- 1st and 2nd place teams will play in the "A" Final
- 3rd and 4th place teams will play in the "B" Final
- 5th and 6th place teams will play in the "C" Final

TIE GAMES IN FINALS

Will be decided as follows - sudden death

- 4 on 4 for 3 minutes with goalies
- 3 on 3 for 3 minutes with goalies
- If still tied, sudden death shoot out (all players on the team must shoot before a player shoots twice)
- If more than one penalty is assessed against a team during 4 on 4 play the non offending team will go to 5 players until the first penalty is finished. If the period comes to an end before the penalty, the play will continue with the non offending team fielding 4 players until the end of the penalty.

RUNNING TIME

A game with a four goal differential at the start of the 3rd period or any time thereafter, running time will commence and continue until the end of the game. Penalties will be 3 minutes during running time.

CLOCK TIME

Games will consist of 3 - 10 minutes stop time periods with a 2 minute warm-up.

- There must be an adult in the dressing room as long as it is occupied by the players
- Dressing room keys can be obtained from the registration office.
- Neither North Dundas Minor Hockey or the Township of North Dundas are responsible for lost or stolen items. Please do not leave valuables in the dressing rooms.
- Please be courteous to our facilities, action will be taken against the party or parties responsible for any damage.
- Please arrive at the arena at least 45 minutes prior to your next game, to give yourself time to check in with the registration office and have team players complete the sign in sheet.
- Please note that all referees' decisions are final and cannot be appealed.
